Retell the story, once they have developed a deep familiarity with the text, some as exact repetition and some in their own words

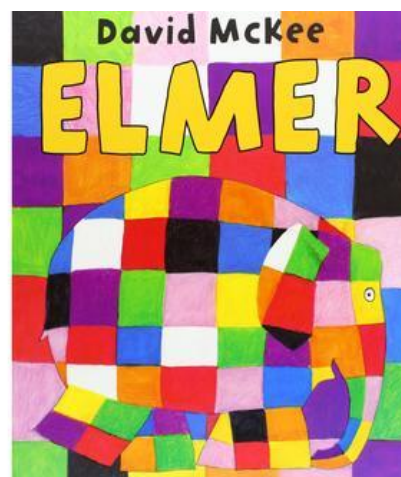
Activities:
