

This year our topics will be looking at; Norfolk, Victorians, Space, Knights, The Great Fire of London and Rainforests.




We will be going on school trips throughout the year to support the children with these topics.

English

In English we will continue to build on what we learned in Year 1 but start to focus more on the spelling, punctuation and grammar of our writing. We will be learning the stories of the Tiger who came to Tea and St Withburga using Pie Corbett actions and then rewriting these stories. We shall also be writing letters to local author Kate Read and writing Fact Files all about Norfolk.

Maths

In maths we will continue to build on what we learned in Year 1. We will be focusing on Place Value this half term. We will be looking at how to partition numbers into hundred, tens and ones using place value charts and part-whole models. We will also be counting in steps of 2, 5, 10 and 3. Then we will be looking at how to solve addition and subtraction problems using a range of mathematical equipment before moving onto more written met

PE

We will be focussing on multiskills and using different equipment to improve these skills. These skills include: kicking, throwing, running and jumping.
